THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

You should know that the church was –

- Built by Jesus – Matt 16:13-18
- Purchased by Christ's blood – Acts 20:28
- Built on Christ as the only foundation – I Cor. 3:11
- Not built on Paul, Apollos, Cephas, or any other man – I Cor 1:12-13
- Fully established on the first Pentecost after Christ arose from the dead – Luke 24:29; Acts 1:8; Mk 9:7; Acts 2nd Chapter

You should know that, in the New Testament the Church is called –

- The Temple of God – I Cor 3:16
- The Bride of Christ – Eph 5:27-32
- The Body of Christ – Col 1:24; Eph 1:22-23
- The Kingdom of God's Son – Col 1:13
- The House of God – I Tim 3:15
- The Church – Eph 3:10
- The Church of God – I Cor 1:2
- The Church of the firstborn – Heb 12:23
- The church of the Lord – Acts 20:28
- The Churches of Christ – Rom 16:16

You should know that members of the church are called –

- Members – I Cor 12:27
- Disciples – Acts 6:1
- Believers – Acts 5:14; II Cor 6:15
- Saints – Acts 9:13; Rom 1:7; Phil 1:1
- Priests – I Peter 2:9; Rev 1:6
- Children – I John 3:1-2
- Christians – Acts 11:26, 28:29; I Peter 4:16

You should know that the three permanent classes of Servants in the church are –

- Elders – who are bishops, overseers and pastors. Their duty is to oversee and feed the flock – Acts 20:28; I Tim 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-7; I Pet 5:1-4
- Deacons – to serve the church – Acts 6:1-6; I Tim 3:8-13
- Evangelists – to teach and preach God's word. For their work and qualifications, see Eph 4:11; 1st & 2nd Timothy and Titus.

You should know that man DID NOT –

- Propose the church – Eph 3:10-11
- Purchase the church – Acts 20:28
- Build the church – Matt 16:18
- Name its people – Acts 11:26; Isa 6:1
- Add to the church – Acts 2:47
- Give the church its doctrine – II John 9:10; Gal 1:11

You should know that the church and the body of Christ are –

- The same – Eph 1:22-23; Col 1:18, 1:24

You should know that Christ himself –

- Loved the church – Eph 5:25
- Bled for the church – Acts 20:28
- Established the church – Matt 16:18
- Called the church His – Matt 16:18
- Added people to the church – Acts 2:47
- Is the head of the church – Eph 5:23, 24, 44; 4:4; 1:22-23
- Will save the church – Eph 5:23; 4:4; 1:22-23

You should know that in order to get into the church you MUST –

- Hear the gospel – Rom 10:17; Acts 2:37
- Believe in Christ – John 8:24; Acts 16:31; Heb 11:16
- Repent of your sins – Luke 13:3; Acts 2:38, 3:19, 17:30
- Confess your faith in Christ – Matt 10:32-33; Rom 10:10, Acts 8:37-38
- Be baptized – Matt 28:19; Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 10:48, 22:16; I Pet 3:21; Gal 3:27

You should know that in the New Testament time there is –

- One family of God – Eph 3:15
- One kingdom of Christ – Col 1:13-14
- One body of Christ – Eph 1:22-23, 4:4
- One bride of Christ – Rom 7:1-7; Eph 5:22-23
- One church of Christ – Matt 16:18; Eph 1:22-23, 4:4

You should know that baptism requires

- Water – Acts 10:47, Much water – John 3:23, Going down into the water – Acts 8:36; Matt 3:5-6, A burial – Rom 6:3-6; Col 2:12, A planting – Rom 6:5, A washing – Acts 22:16, A birth – John 3:5, A raising out of the water – Col 2:12, A coming up out of the water – Act 8:39
